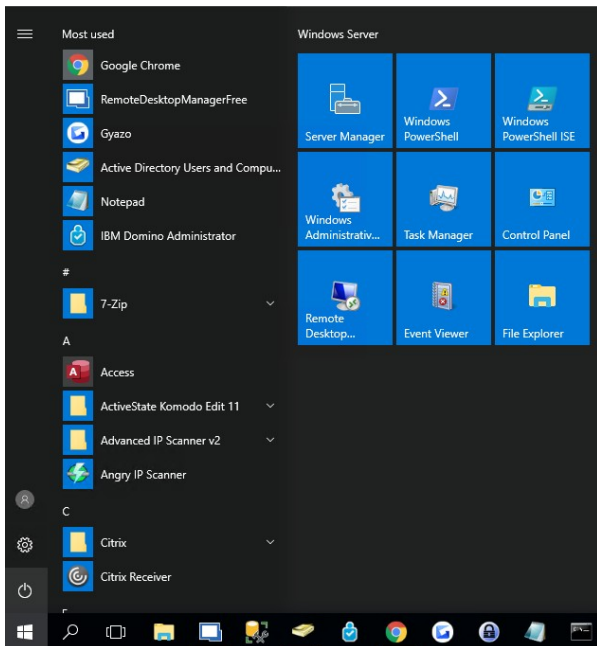
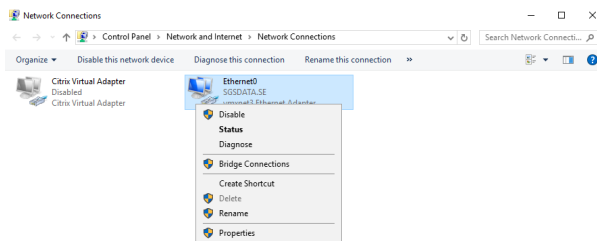


How to setup DHCP on Windows 10

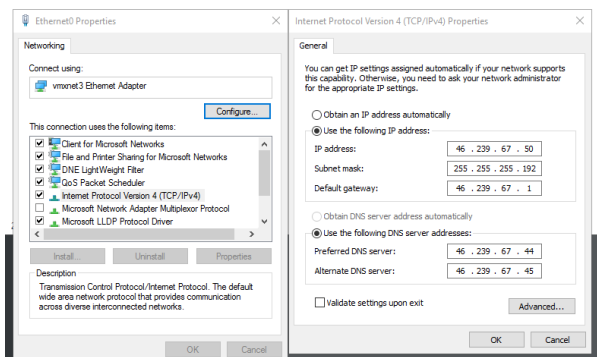
In this guide it is assumed that you are using Windows 10. It shows you how to configure Windows 10 to automatically get an IP-address through DHCP.



1. Click on **Windows logotype – Control Panel**
2. Click on **Network and Internet**
3. Click on **Network and Sharing Center**
4. Click on **Change adapter settings**



4. Right click on **Local Area Connection** and choose **Properties**.



5. Highlight **Internet Protocol Version 4** and click on **Properties**.
6. Choose **Obtain IP address automatically** and
7. Choose **Obtain DNS server automatically**
8. Click **OK**.

Now you can use your Internet connection.
