



How to setup DHCP on Windows 7

In this guide it is assumed that you are using Windows 7. It shows you how to configure Windows 7 to automatically get an IP-address through DHCP.




1. Click on **Windows logotype – Control Panel**
2. Click on **Network and Internet**
3. Click on **Network and Sharing Center**
4. Click on **Change adapter settings**




4. Right click on **Local Area Connection** and choose **Properties**.

This connection uses the following items:



5. Highlight **Internet Protocol Version 4** and click on **Properties**.



6. Choose **Obtain IP address automatically** and
7. Choose **Obtain DNS server automatically**
8. Click **OK**.

Now you can use your Internet connection.
